

Pro-Life Campus Club Grant

For the 2013-2014 School Year

Purpose of the Grant: The grant recognizes the work of pro-life clubs and assists them in their efforts on campuses. The grant will be given to the club whose proposal demonstrates creativity, planning, and leadership, fulfilling their mission as a club and having a substantial impact on the university culture.

Grant Process: This \$1500 grant is sponsored by the Interim and Niagara Right to Life and facilitated by National Campus Life Network. Clubs who wish to apply will submit a completed application to NCLN, which includes the event proposal and a tentative budget found below. The successful club will be chosen by the Grant Sponsors, with recommendations from National Campus Life Network's staff who work with the groups throughout the year. The grant will be awarded in December and all applicants will be notified. The successful club is expected to update the Grant Sponsors about their club activities, and will have an opportunity to be interviewed by the Interim.
